Ann showed us a very interesting scarf that her mother knitted from handspun camel and alpaca fibre. Ann has three camels and collects the fibre by either brushing or just collecting it as it falls off in Spring. It is a short soft fibre.

Debbie showed the finished slip stitch jumper for her grandson Harry. So cute for a toddler. She is also knitting a baby jacket

in a white commercial Australian Alpaca yarn in an effective basket weave stitch.
